5. Is heaven "one big camping trip"? Pastor explained why we should think differently. What is the purpose of the book of Revelation?

6. What is the biggest problem with vacation? Pastor compared it to the entrance into heaven. What does God require for us to get to heaven (on our own efforts)? Can anyone pay? Why or why not?

7. Have you disqualified yourself from heaven (with your efforts)? Why or why not? Why then, according to verse four, can you rejoice as catch a glimpse of heaven? What does that mean?

8. In verse 5, John assures us of one final fact of heaven. What is it?

9. What Bible saints inspire you? What fact from their life helps you? What Christian saints who've died are your examples? What quality from their life inspires you to serve God? And what living Christian saints are your models of faith? What do they do to inspire you?

10. How can God use you to be a Christian example to others?
