1. Name several reasons why people are afraid of the dark. Are you afraid of the dark? Why or why not?
2. Describe what Pastor said about how dark is it in the National Park: "Mammoth Cave" in Kentucky?
3. What is "phosphorescence"?
4. In the Bible, God uses physical terms to explain spiritual reality. What does darkness refer to in the Bible? What does light refer to? Why does that matter today?
5. Why does the Bible call us "sinners" in V8? Pastor explained we can't escape the spiritual darkness we were born with. Why?
6. God "turns on the light" when we read His Word. In V14, God's Word says: "Wake up O sleeper." Who is that referring to?
7. How did Christ's perfect life benefit us? How did Christ act for as "the Light of the Word"?
8. How does Jesus "light the way" for us this week as we spend time thanking him for our salvation?
