Sermon Text: Matthew 9: 35 – 10:8

*Sermon Theme: "Christianity Is NOT
a Spectator Sport"*

1. What is a spectator sport? How do some people treat their Christian faith like a spectator sport? What can negatively happen?
2. Are you more of a fan or a follower of Jesus Christ? Prove your point with several examples.
3. What did Jesus mean in v37 that "the harvest is plentiful but the workers are few"? How does that impact your life?
4. How do you look at each person you saw this past week? How does Christ want us to look at each person? Why does that matter?
5. Why are we sometimes slow to share the saving name of Christ with others? How does the Savior Jesus help us with our witnessing?
6. Using our sermon text, what are some things you will pray to God for this week?
7. Jesus called 12 ordinary men to do extraordinary things as his disciples. How does that help you listen to Christ more intently?
8. How would an earthly consulting firm evaluate the personalities of the 12 disciples? Which one do you think was most effective? Which one was least effective? Give reasons for your answers.
